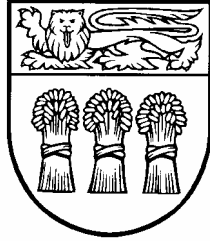

The following persons are not eligible to be appointed a presiding Justice of the Peace:

- a practicing barrister and solicitor in the Province of Saskatchewan;
- an employee of the Government of Saskatchewan or a Crown Corporation;
- an employee of the Government of Canada or a Crown Corporation;
- an employee or member of a police force within the meaning of *The Police Act* or the Royal Canadian Mounted Police;
- a member of the Corp of Commissionaires;
- an elected member of a council of a municipality, or legislature.

Appointment to a Justice of the Peace requires:

- that you are a Canadian citizen;
- that you attend and successfully complete a training course;
- that you submit a monthly report to Saskatchewan Justice stating the duties you performed.

This application process can take a few months to complete. If at anytime during the process you decide to withdraw your name, because of a change in your personal or business situations, please advise our office immediately.
