CHAPTER M-21 REG 1
The Mortgage Brokers Act

Title

- 1 These regulations may be cited as *The Mortgage Brokers Regulations*.

Fee

- 2 The fee payable for a mortgage broker's licence is \$150.

Exemption from licence

- 3 The licensing provisions of *The Mortgage Brokers Act* do not apply to:

- (a) a corporation, with respect to mortgages given to it by:
 - (i) its employees in conjunction with a scheme or arrangement to provide housing for its employees; or
 - (ii) its dealers, agents or lessees;
- (b) a loan company licensed pursuant to *The Trust and Loan Corporations Act*;
- (c) any person who does not participate in the negotiations of a mortgage transaction with the mortgagor.
