Remember, if you must escape through smoke, get low under the smoke where air is cooler and cleaner. Unscramble the words below so you will get out safely.



Parent Fire Safety Tip

Remember...

- Smoke alarms save lives, but only if they are working!
- To make sure they are working, test them once a month.
- To test smoke alarms, push the test button. Alarm should sound in 20 seconds.
- Replace smoke alarm batteries once a year or as needed.
- Replace smoke alarms older than 10 years with new ones.
- Make sure your whole family knows what to do when the smoke alarm sounds!
- On a floor plan of your home, draw the escape route in case of a fire.
- Practise your escape plan with the family twice a year.
