IMPORTANT

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT to attend this hearing or to be represented by a lawyer retained by you. The court may order that your lawyer's fee be paid out of the assets of the estate, if it appears that his services were reasonably necessary.

YOU ALSO HAVE THE RIGHT at this hearing:

- (1) to obtain explanations concerning matters not clear to you;
- (2) to object to any items in the accounts which may appear to you to be questionable;
- (3) to make known any complaints you may have regarding the administration of the estate;
- (4) to object to the amount of the fee claimed by the personal representative and request that the court allow some lesser amount than \$ \_\_\_\_\_;
- (5) to apply for an order that the lawyer who acted for the personal representative be allowed lesser fees than are provided by The court rules for estates of average complexity, if you consider this estate was unusually simple.

TAKE NOTICE that if you do not attend, in person or by counsel the hearing will proceed in your absence.
