SNOWMOBILERS SHOULD AVOID FLOODWAY CONSTRUCTION ZONES

Over the next four years, work on the Red River Floodway Expansion Project will create an “active construction zone” along the length of the floodway channel. This will mean that workers and heavy equipment will be on site at all times and new construction hazards will arise and change throughout the year.

As a result, the public, and in particular snowmobilers, should avoid travel on the floodway to ensure their safety and the safety of workers on the project. Please remember, workers operating heavy equipment are concentrating on the work they are doing and do not expect to have children or individuals – either on foot or snowmobile - in the vicinity of where they are working.

Thank you for your cooperation in keeping the construction site safe for the public and for floodway workers.
