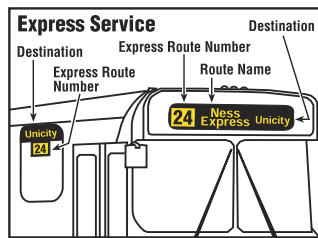

RIDE BY ROUTE NUMBER

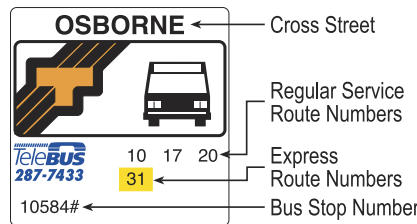
Winnipeg Transit identifies bus routes by a **route number**, a **route name** and **route destination**. The route name is usually the major street on which the bus travels. The route destination shows where the bus is going.



BUS STOP SIGNS

Bus stop signs show this information:

- The nearest cross street or destination
- The bus stop number
- The Telebus phone number
- The route numbers for the stop location



TELEBUS

Each bus stop sign in Winnipeg shows a five-digit bus stop number. When you call Telebus at 287-7433 and enter this number, a recorded message will tell you when the bus will arrive at that bus stop.

You can also find Telebus information and maps in the Winnipeg Yellow Pages with the red edge, under Transit Guide, Telebus Directory and Maps. View the website at winnipegtransit.com. Click on Navigo for an individual trip map.

POWER HOUR TRANSFERS

Ask for a transfer when you pay your fare on the bus. Transfers are valid only on the day they are issued. They allow you to travel in any direction for an hour until the expiry time. This includes a return trip on the same route.

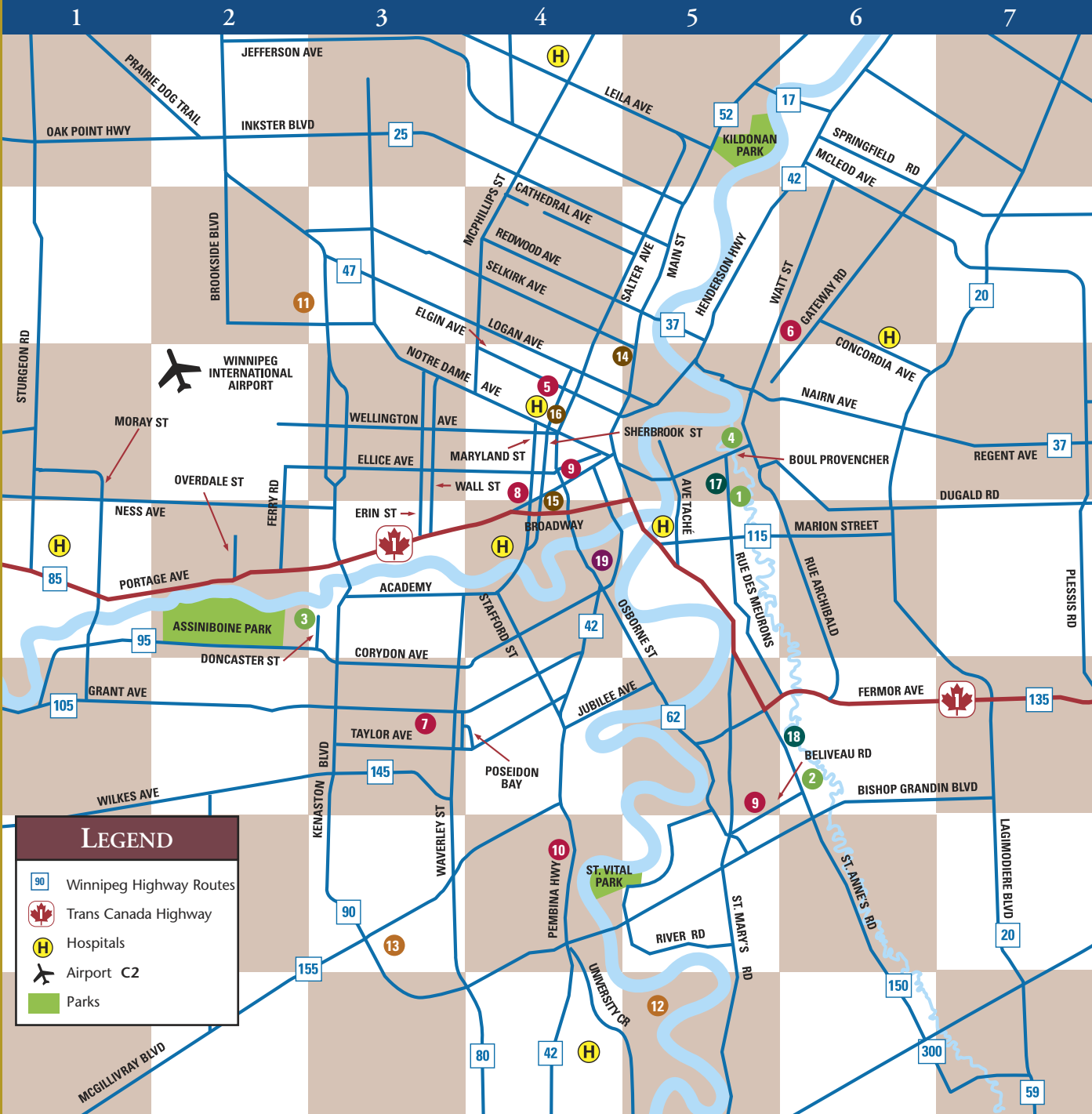

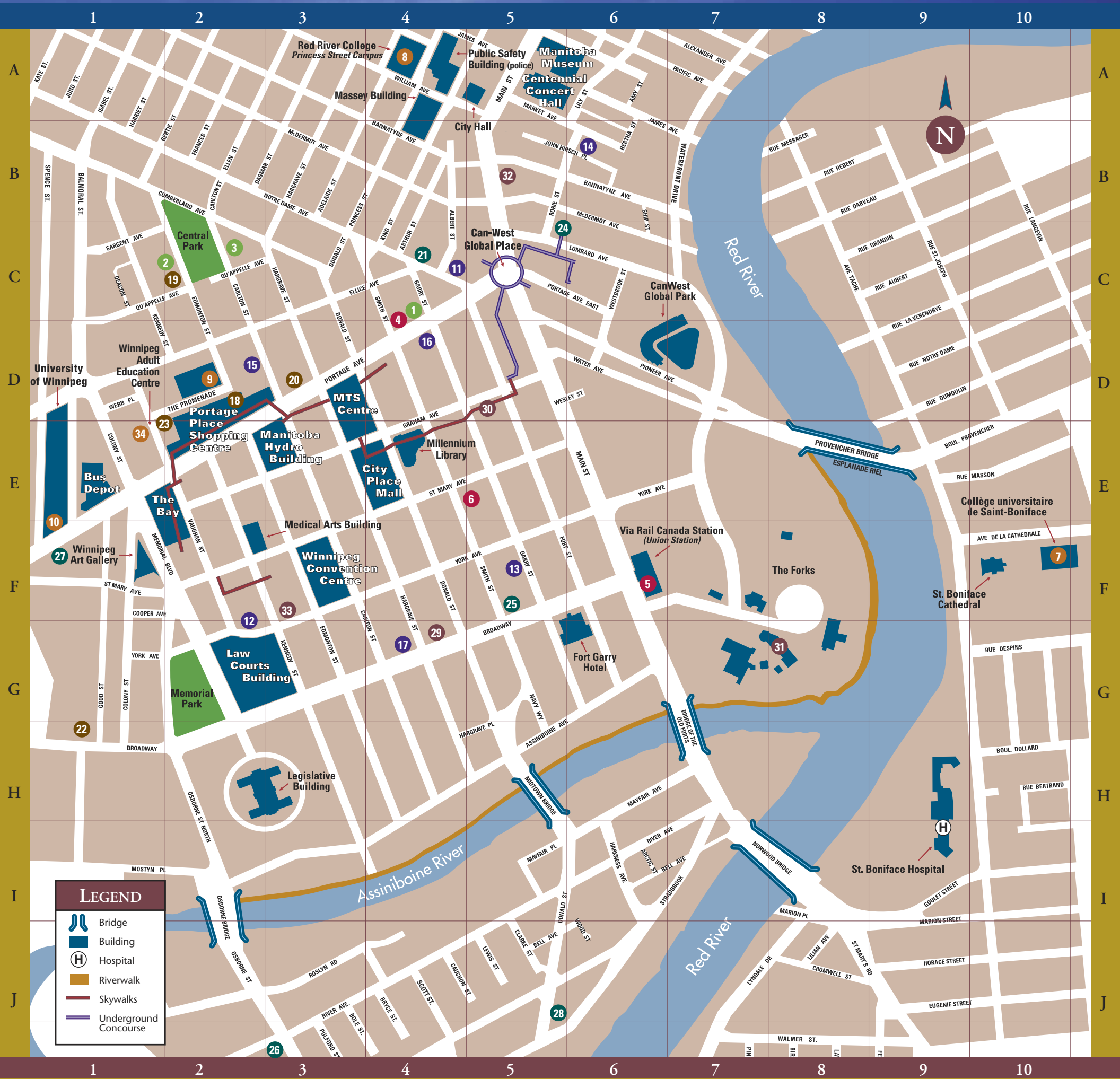
