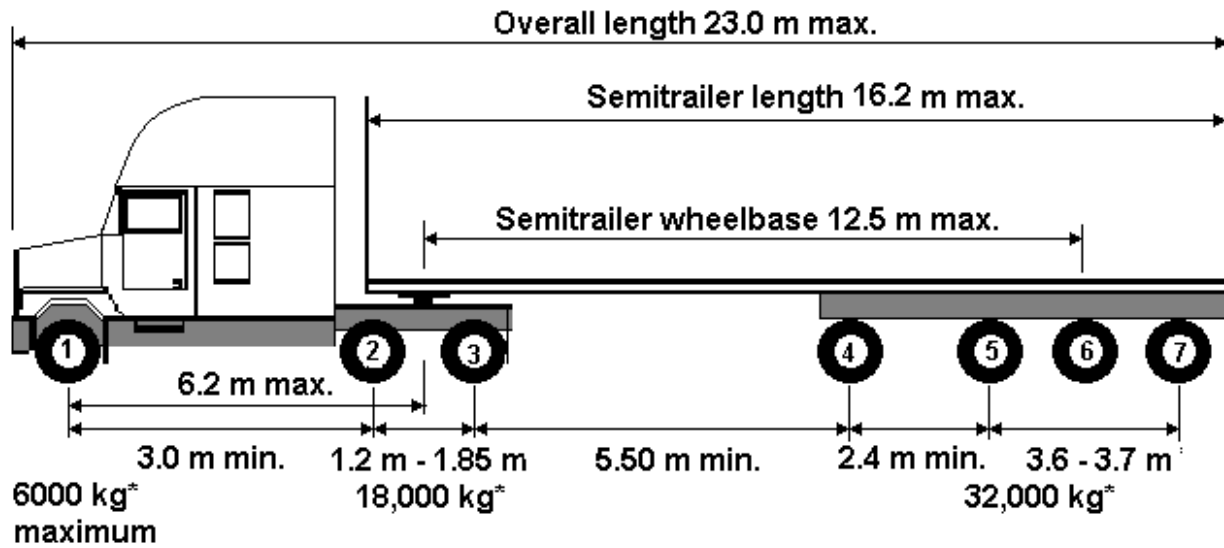
Does the semi-trailer comply with the following requirements? Yes No

- The air pressure for the lift axle must not be controlled from within the cab.
- The lift axle may be fully lifted or fully lowered from within the cab.
- Semi-trailer axle group 5, 6 and 7 must be a tridem group utilizing a full air suspension system.
- Axle 4 must be pneumatically tied into the tridem axle group 5, 6 and 7
- For axle group 4, 5, 6, and 7, the load must be equalized between adjacent axles in the group to within 1000 kg.
- Only axle 4 may be a lift axle or a self-steering axle.

Vehicles must register to the gross vehicle weight authorized on the NCLL permit for permit to be valid. Tractor must register the steer weight authorized on the NCLL permit, if it is in excess of 5500 kg, for NCLL permit to be valid. Registration must be in accordance with the New Brunswick Regulation 2001-67.

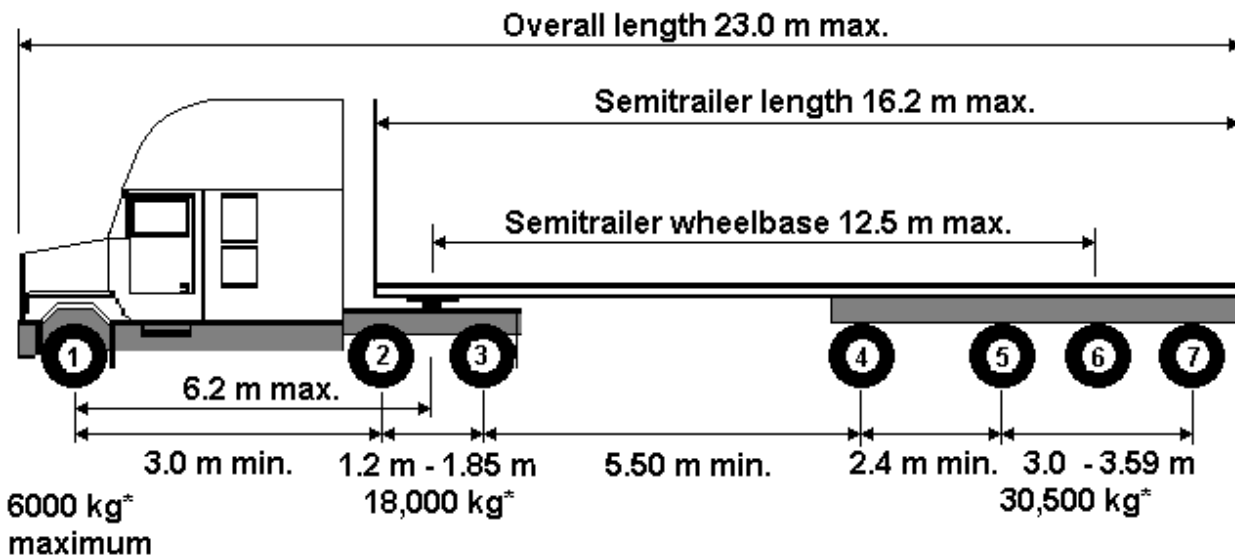
Truck and semi trailer combinations must comply with either diagram #1 or #2 below.

Vehicle #2 – GVW = 54,000 kg maximum*



*** NOTE: No additional weight (mass) will be permitted beyond these values.**

Note: For the above diagrams #1 and #2:

- All other vehicle dimensions must comply with Regulation 2001-67
- All axles except steering axle must be equipped with dual tires
- All axles on trailer must utilize a full air suspension that equalizes the load between the axles to within 1000 kg
- All four axles of the semi-trailer must be deployed when trailer is loaded and operating

This vehicle may be inspected during the term of said permit, to evaluate its safety and weight distribution characteristics. I further understand that an unsatisfactory carrier safety rating may be grounds for not issuing a permit, or subsequent cancellation of a permit.
