Camp Morton Provincial Park (Remove 7.2 meters from the western park boundary for improved highway conditions and safety of motorists)

Norris Lake Provincial Park (Reduction of the eastern park boundary by 10 meters for improved highway conditions and safety of motorists)

Hecla/Grindstone & Elk Island Provincial Parks (Correct survey plans to include updated definition of the Ordinary High Water Mark for Lake Winnipeg to allow for the creation of protected Land Use Categories in provincial parks adjacent to water bodies.

Duck Mountain Provincial Park (Extension of Access Land Use Category around the Brush Creek Pit area to correct an error in the legal survey plan. The change will allow the continued use of this valuable gravel source for park and area roads)

Oak Lake Provincial Park (Correction of the original survey description to reflect an accurate location of park)

Memorial Heritage Park (Correct the legal survey plan to reflect the widening of Osborne Street north of York Avenue in the early 1990s)
