Introduction

The purpose of this public drop-in session is to:

- 1. Provide an opportunity for public input on proposed changes to regulations, or boundaries for provincial parks
- 2. Provide notification on the intent to update provincial park boundary or regulation changes.

The Provincial Parks Act (1993) requires public consultation and input when proposing changes to Provincial Parks. This requirement is specified in Section 9(1) of *The Act*:

Before a regulation is made under section 7 [establishment of park designation, classification and land use categories] or subsection 8(2) [renewal of park reserve designation], the minister shall provide an opportunity for public consultation and shall seek advice about proposed regulations

The information at this public drop-in session has been grouped together to use department resources more effectively.

For proposed provincial park boundary or regulation changes, feedback forms are available for written comments or suggestions. All feedback will be reviewed and considered by staff at the Parks and Natural Areas Branch of Manitoba Conservation.
