Reporting to the Marine Captain, the Marine Engineer is responsible for maintaining and repairing the ferry's engine and onboard equipment. Performs routine checks and planned service and maintenance of the ferry in order to keep the ferry in safe working condition. The incumbent is also responsible for performing electrical maintenance.

The knowledge, skills and abilities required to perform these duties would normally be obtained through the attainment of a 4th Class Marine Engineering certificate and 3 years directly related experience. A valid class 5 driver's license is also required. Successfully candidate must have the ability to meet the following requirements within the first season of employment; Valid Medical Certificate and Valid Marine First Aide.
