Marine Refit Engineer

Department of Transportation Non-Traditional, Indeterminate Position Fort Simpson, NT

Reporting to the Marine Captain during running season and to the Manager Marine Engineering in the off-season, the Marine Engineer is responsible for maintaining and repairing the ferry's engine and onboard equipment. Performs routine checks and planned service and maintenance of the ferry in order to keep the ferry in safe working condition. The incumbent is also responsible for performing electrical maintenance. In the off-season, the Refit Engineer shall carry out refit work on GNWT ferries as required to ensure they are ready for the next season.

The knowledge, skills and abilities required to perform these duties would normally be obtained through the attainment of a 3rd Class Marine Engineering certificate and 5 years directly related experience is preferred. A valid class 5 driver's license is also required. Successful candidate must have the ability to meet the following requirements within the first season of employment; Valid Medical Certificate and Valid Marine First Aide. Equivalencies will be considered.

The salary ranges from \$31.98 to \$33.64 per hour plus a Northern Allowance of \$4.49 per hour is provided.
