

Marine Deckhand - Relief Seasonal Non-Traditional Occupation Department of Transportation Fort Simpson, NWT

The Department of Transportation is recruiting for one Relief Marine Deckhand for the Liard River Crossing Ferry at Fort Simpson to work on a seasonal basis from May to October.

Reporting to the Ferry Mate and in the absence of the Ferry Mate, reports to the Marine Captain, the Deckhand is responsible for loading/unloading passengers and vehicles onto and off ferry, performs deck maintenance function, operate deck equipment aboard the ferry and operates heavy equipment on shore to rebuild push-outs on an as needed basis.

The qualifications for this position are normally acquired through certification approved by Transport Canada. Marine Emergency Duties Certificate(or obtain within 6 months after hiring). Valid Medical Examination Certificate, Valid Marine First Aid Certificate(or obtain within 6 months after hiring), and a Class Five Drivers License with ability to operate a loader are required. Marine background sufficient to demonstrate the knowledge, and skill requirements of the job. An equivalent combination of education and/or experience will be considered.

The salary ranges from \$24.86 to \$26.14 per hour, plus a Northern Allowance of \$4.49 per hour is provided.
