NORTHWEST TERRITORIES AND THE TERRITORY OF NUNAVUT

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR AN INSURANCE ADJUSTER'S LICENCE

(Excluding Life and Accident & Sickness)

- 1. Applicants should complete Form #7 (attached).
- 2. New applicants (not licensed in any jurisdiction) are required to pass the General Insurance Examination prepared by the Insurance Institute of Canada before a licence can be issued. *
- 3. Non-resident applicants must submit an *original*, personal non-resident endorsement, certificate of agent status, or certificate of authority not more than three (3) months old, from the appropriate licensing authority in their home jurisdiction. This document must be issued to the Northwest Territories or the Territory of Nunavut on behalf of the applicant.
- 4. There is no provision for corporate licensing, the licence is issued to individual applicants.
- 5. The fee is \$100.00 for resident applicants and \$150.00 for non-resident applicants. Please make your cheque payable to the Government of the Northwest Territories or the Government of Nunavut, whichever applies.
- 6. Make sure a Commissioner of Oaths witnesses the Affidavit.
