



FEES PAYABLE BY INSURERS FOR LICENCES AND SERVICES IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES AND TERRITORY OF NUNAVUT

Joint Stock companies and by mutual companies:

Life Insurance \$330.00

Fire Insurance \$330.00

And any insurance against any risk relating to the property to which a fire insurance policy relates that is effected by a contract, supplemental to the policy and that is ordinarily effected by what is commonly known as "an additional perils supplemental contract," and also fire insurance, either alone or combined with one more of the following; use and occupancy, rent, profit, weather, inland marine, inland transportation, sprinkler leakage, explosion, falling aircraft, strikes, riots or civil commotion, or earthquake.

Accident \$220.00

(including vehicle and public liability), either alone or combined with one or more of the following, sickness and health, guarantee, suretyship, burglary, liability and automobile insurance)

Hail Insurance \$ 25.00

One or more of the following: \$ 50.00

Automobile guarantee, plate glass, burglary, steam boiler (**boiler & machinery**), weather, inland marine, inland transportation, sprinkler leakage, explosion, liability livestock insurance, or any **other class of insurance not enumerated above**.

Discontinued undertaking

\$ 10.00

For insurers who has discontinued undertaking or renewing insurance contracts in the Territories <u>except</u> insurers <u>renewing life insurance policies</u>.

Mutual Benefit and Fraternal Societies:

Transacting life insurance:

Under 500 member in the NWT or Nunavut \$100.00 500 or more members in the NWT or Nunavut \$200.00

Transacting accident & sickness insurance or both:

Under 500 members in the NWT or Nunavut \$100.00 500 or more members in the NWT or Nunavut \$200.00

Reciprocal and Inter-insurance Exchanges Licence \$200.00

Fee charged to issuance of duplicate copy of licence, amendment or certificate of good standing \$ 25.00

An insurers licence in both Territories expires June 30th following the date of issue. Licence fees are prorated to one-half when the application for *initial* licence is made when six months had already elapsed during the licensing year.
