## 2006 Manitoba Vote on the Canadian Wheat Board Eligibility Criteria

All producers with a direct economic stake in the Canadian Wheat Board are eligible to cast one vote. Specific eligibility criteria are as follows:

## Wheat

 Producers that actually produced wheat in 2005 and/or 2006, or were entitled to a share of the wheat crop as a landlord in 2005 and/or 2006 are eligible to cast a vote.

## Barley

 Producers that actually produced barley in 2005 and/or 2006, or were entitled to a share of the barley crop as a landlord in 2005 and/or 2006 are eligible to cast a vote.

The following individuals within each farm legal structure are eligible to vote, subject to a maximum of one vote per person:

<b>Type of Farming Enterprise</b>	Individuals that are eligible to Vote
Sole Proprietorship	Owner
Partnership	Each Legal Partner
Corporations / Colonies	Each Legal Shareholder
Crop-share Landlords	Same as above

If you or someone you know has been omitted from a voters' list, a Declaration must be filled out and signed by a Commissioner for Oaths or a Notary Public. Declaration forms can be downloaded from the Manitoba Agriculture, Food and Rural Initiatives website at <a href="https://www.gov.mb.ca/agriculture">www.gov.mb.ca/agriculture</a>. Alternatively, you can pick-up a form at any MAFRI GO Centre or Office throughout the Province.

All GO Centres and Offices will be staffed with a Commissioner for Oaths for your use, free of charge, for these Declarations.

## All Declarations MUST be completed by December 18, 2006 to be accepted.
