



Special Occasion Permit Conditions

The permit holder is responsible for assuring that all laws, regulations and policies made under the *Liquor Control Act* are respected and obeyed.

Please be aware, the following conditions are attached to your permit and must be adhered to:

- The permit must be located at the bar area.
- Premises cannot be open to the general public.
- Only members and/or invited guests are permitted on the premises.
- Admission cannot be charged at the door.
- Liquor cannot be sold for more than the price indicated on the permit.
- Persons under 19 years cannot be served and are not permitted on the premises unless for a wedding or wedding anniversary.
- Only liquor authorized under the special occasion permit can be on-site on the date specified on the permit.
- Advertisement of the occasion is not allowed.
- All liquor at this function must be purchased by the permit holder or authorized purchaser through an NB Liquor Outlet only. **(No homemade alcoholic products or "BYOB" is permitted on site).**
- All remaining liquor must be taken from the premises after the event.
- Donated inventory cannot be returned to a NBLC Outlet.
- Liquor Sales must end at 2:00 a.m. or before and guests must vacate the premises no later than 2:30 a.m.
