

Program for Periodical Publishers – Guidelines

Objective

This program is intended to support the publication of literary, performing and visual arts periodicals that serve as outlets for the writers of fiction, poetry, drama and literary criticism or that report on the visual or performing arts in New Brunswick.

Program Details

This program provides two opportunities for funding. It offers eligible publishers:

1. An **annual grant** of up to 15% of their total operating costs, to a maximum of \$5,000.
2. A **special editions grant** of up to 50% of project costs for special editions highlighting the arts or culture, to a maximum of \$3,000.

Applicant Eligibility

Applications under these programs shall be limited to:

- Wholly Canadian-owned companies or non-profit cultural organizations whose chief place of business is located in New Brunswick. In exceptional cases, periodicals that are published in other provinces of the Atlantic region and that are of a regional scope are eligible for assistance;
- Established arts periodicals whose regular program of publishing has included no fewer than three issues.

Note: publications which are primarily bulletins or house organs are not eligible for consideration.

How to Apply

Applications for assistance should be made in writing by the publisher, editor or manager of the periodical. Requests must be accompanied by a copy of each of the three most recent issues of the magazine.

Requests for a *special editions grant* must also include a full description of the project and its budget, detailing all relevant publishing costs and anticipated sources of revenue.

Application Deadline

Applications should be received at the Arts Development Branch **no later than April 15th**.

Grant Requirement

The Province of New Brunswick should receive appropriate credit for its support in all publicity associated with the publication.
