VIDEO GAMES

EARLY CHILDHOOD



May be suitable for ages 3 and older. Contains no material that parents would find inappropriate.

EVERYONE



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May be suitable for ages 6 and older. Titles in this category may contain minimal cartoon, fantasy or mild violence and/or infrequent use of mild language.

EVERYONE 10+



May be suitable for ages 10 and older. Titles in this category may contain more cartoons, fantasy or mild violence, mild language, and/or minimal suggestive themes.

TEEN



May be suitable for ages 13 and older. Titles in this category may contain violence, suggestive themes, crude humor, minimal blood, simulated gambling and/or infrequent use of strong language.

MATURE



ATURE 17+

May be suitable for persons age 17 and older. Titles in this category may contain intense violence, blood and gore, sexual content and/or strong language. In Manitoba, must be 17 or older to rent/buy a "Mature" video game.

ADULTS ONLY



Should only be played by persons 18 years and older. Titles in this category may include prolonged scenes of intense violence and/or graphic sexual content and nudity. In Manitoba, must be 18 or older to rent/buy "Adult Only" video game.



Many titles also carry content descriptors on the back of the game packaging and in game advertising.

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
