Economic Overview

Dawson Bay was first settled as a fishing site by fishermen who commercially fished the bay and Lake Winnipegosis. The community continues to serve as a harbour and now has a fish packing plant, which operates in both summer and winter seasons.

There is limited trapping in open areas.

Although agriculture has not been developed, there is potential for some mixed farming. The soil, which is quite stony, produces good gardens.
