Herb Lake Landing is situated on the east shore of Wekusko Lake approximately 6 kilometres north of PR #391. It is also 55 kilometres southeast of Snow Lake. PR #391 is an all-weather paved road connecting to PTH #6 and north to Thompson, or to PTH #10 and south-west to The Pas.

Herb Lake Landing was originally a landing point on the trail from the CNR Bay Line to a mine further north on the lake. When the mine closed, only the landing remained.
