Loon Straits is located on the east shore of Lake Winnipeg diagonally opposite Washow Bay, and about 50 kilometres north of Manigotagan.

There is a seasonal access road connection to the timber-haul road. Other access is gained by boat and barge from Calder's dock on the west shore, about 11 km across the narrow portion of the lake. Float and ski-plane access and winter road access are alternate transportation modes.
