
CA 1.0 NLH

CA 2.0 NLH

In reference to the response to PUB 6.0 NLH, what is the cost of transmission operating and maintenance cost in the most recently approved cost of service study in total dollars, and \$/km of transmission? What is the length of the interconnection with AUR Resources Inc? What is the operation and maintenance cost component included in Hydro's currently approved wheeling rate, and how is it calculated?
