BIOGRAPHY

The album "Another Time" is a collection of traditional Newfoundland songs, performed by some of Newfoundland's leading folk musicians. It was produced by Pigeon Inlet Productions, Newfoundland's only independent folk/roots music label, and released in 1991.

The album is a re-recording of old favourites, many of the songs being drawn from the *Gerald S. Doyle Songbooks*. Producers Kelly Russell and Don Walsh selected 30 songs, which they then distributed to approximately 20 musicians to get their input on arrangement. Appearing on the album are singers Vonnie Barron, Anita Best, Roger Howse, Ron Hynes, James Joyce, Pamela Morgan, Fergus O'Byrne, Dermot O'Reilly, Dave Panting, Esther Squires. The arrangements are new and daring, providing an exciting and fresh approach to hearing and interpreting traditional Newfoundland songs.
