1. In accordance with the *Wilderness and Ecological Reserves Act*, and pursuant regulations and policies, commercial operators require a permit to conduct business in wilderness and ecological reserves.
2. A separate application is required for each vessel.
3. Documentation with respect to the Transport Canada Safety Inspection Certificate and proof of Liability Insurance must be submitted to the Department of Environment and Conservation by **April 15th** of each year. Failure to submit the documentation required may result in the Department's refusal to issue a licence or cancellation of an existing licence.
4. Please allow a minimum of two weeks for your application to be processed.
5. If a permit is granted, Parks and Natural Areas Division is not responsible for the passengers, crew or vessels within the Ecological Reserve.
6. If a permit is granted, the applicant will be required to submit an Annual Report summarizing the number of visitors carried into the reserve and the number of boat trips per year. This information must be reported by the end of the calendar year of operation (**December 31**).
