Section 2: Specific Information

The following information must be provided and attached to the application form. Applications not including this information will not be processed.

1. Title of the proposed study.
2. Objective(s) of the proposed study.
3. Detailed description of the proposed methodology, including background information on the study area and trends of the study populations, and full disclosure of any proposed removal or displacement of materials (plants, insects, animals, sand, etc.).
4. Expected duration of the proposed study, including start and end dates of both field work and final analysis.
5. Names, positions, affiliations and professional/technical qualifications of all individuals involved in the proposed study.
6. Any other permits required (e.g. Canadian Wildlife Service, Animal Care, Inland Fish and Wildlife Division).

*** NOTE ***

1. In accordance with the *Provincial Parks Act*, the *Wilderness and Ecological Reserves Act*, and pursuant regulations and policies, scientific research shall not occur within a park or reserve unless specifically authorized in writing by means of a Scientific Research Permit.
2. Please allow a minimum of two weeks for your application to be processed. Research applications for seabird ecological reserves must be submitted by January 31 in order to be reviewed by the Seabird Ecological Reserve Advisory Committee in late winter.
3. If a permit is granted, the applicant must submit an annual Field Report, Final Report by January 31 of the final year of research, and any published material resulting from the work. The reports must specify the title stated on the permit and the name of the permit holder. Other conditions may apply.
