





Tory Support Slides in New Year

To follow is a review of the latest Nanos national random telephone survey of Canadians 18 years of age and older. It was completed between February 2nd and February 4th, 2008. The statistics of committed voters for the current wave is accurate to within 3.4 percentage points, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20. The margin of accuracy will be wider for sub samples. Percentages may exceed 100 due to rounding.

The research was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which Nanos is a Gold Seal Corporate member.

METHODOLOGY

Between February 2nd and February 4th, 2008, Nanos Research conducted a random telephone survey of 1,002 Canadians 18 years and older on behalf of CPAC. The aggregate survey results are accurate ±3.1 %, 19 times out of 20. Margins of accuracy are wider for subgroup samples. Readers should note that the data was weighted for age to match the latest Canadian census results. Results should be considered representative of the Canadian population. Results may not add up to 100% due to rounding.
