



Federal Deadlock Continues

To follow is a review of the latest Nanos national random telephone survey of Canadians 18 years of age and older. It was completed between February 16th and February 20th, 2008. The statistics of committed voters for the current wave is accurate to within 3.3 percentage points, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20. The margin of accuracy will be wider for sub samples. Percentages may exceed 100 due to rounding.

The research was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which Nanos is a Gold Seal Corporate member. For those parties you would consider voting for federally, could you please rank your top two current local preferences? (Committed Voters Only - First Preference)
