# **VANCOUVER BLUE BOX** AND APARTMENT RECYCLABLES

**CONTAINERS:** metal cans glass bottles and jars, aluminum foil, foil containers, plastic containers & & & &.

**NEWSPRINT**: newspapers, newspaper inserts.

PAPER PRODUCTS: writing paper, junk mail, envelopes, cardboard, magazines, catalogues, phone books, paper bags, pizza boxes, etc.

Use the City of Vancouver residential recycling program and recycling depot. Single-family residences are supplied with blue boxes and blue and yellow bags; multi-family buildings are suppled with wheeled blue

# **BEVERAGE CONTAINERS** WITH DEPOSITS

includes all except milk containers (milk containers are not banned from the garbage).



Use the Return-It beverage container recycling program to return these to a depot or a retailer and get your deposit back. Milk containers are also taken at participating depots, but there is no deposit paid or refunded.

# YARD AND GARDEN TRIMMINGS

grass clippings, leaves, weeds, dry seed cones, hedge clippings, brush, branches.



Use the City of Vancouver residential yard trimmings collection program (wheeled grey carts with green lids) or take to the City's depot. Apartments can call to arrange service if required.

specifically desktop computers, monitors, keyboards, mice, desktop servers, portable computers (except handheld devices), desktop printers and televisions.


# OIL, OIL FILTERS AND **EMPTY OIL CONTAINERS**
