## MANITOBA MINERAL EXPLORATION TAX CREDIT

Complete this form to calculate your Manitoba mineral exploration tax credit. You can claim this credit if you received an Information slip T101, *Statement of Resource Expenses*, from a mining corporation, or an Information slip T5013, *Statement of Partnership Income*, received as a member of a partnership, with an amount in box 144.

The credits you earned in 2002 are used to reduce your Manitoba tax payable for that year. Any unused amount can be claimed in a future taxation year.

**Attach a copy** of Information slip T101 and/or T5013 to this form and include it with your paper return. If you are filing electronically, keep a copy of the documents for your records in case further verification is required.
