Statement of Farming Activities for Ontario and New Brunswick Self Directed Risk Management (SDRM)

General information

Ontario and New Brunswick producers: For the 2002 stabilization year, the Self Directed Risk Management (SDRM) Pilot Project will provide edible horticulture producers with the opportunity to make additional deposits to their NISA accounts and receive enhanced matching contributions on most edible horticulture crops for which they have not taken crop insurance. See the commodity list at the back of the Farming Income and NISA guide for more information.

If you are in the SDRM program, complete Form T1163, Statement A – NISA Account Information and Statement of Farming Activities for Individuals, and complete one copy of this form to record your SDRM commodities.

Submit all forms together in one package.
