

YUKON RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT TAX CREDIT (INDIVIDUALS)

Use this form to calculate your refundable Yukon research and development (R&D) tax credit. If you are completing a return for a corporation, use Schedule 442 of the T2 return.

Form T1232 has to be filed no later than 12 months after your filing due date for the year in which the expenditures were incurred.

You may qualify for this credit if you made eligible expenditures in the tax year. An **eligible expenditure** is one that meets the definition under "qualified expenditure" in subsection 127(9) of the federal *Income Tax Act*, incurred by you in the tax year in respect of scientific research and experimental development carried on in the Yukon. You must have been a resident in Yukon on the last day of the tax year to qualify.

Please give details of your eligible expenditures on a separate sheet of paper. **Attach** this sheet and a completed copy of this form to your paper return. If you are filing electronically, keep all your documents in case we ask to see them.
