Yukon Tax Instructions

What's new for 2005

The base amounts and the tax on base amounts have changed.

See below for more information about the following amounts:

- · allowable political contribution tax credit; and
- Yukon mineral exploration tax credit and research and development tax credit.

Line 25 - Allowable political contribution tax credit

A trust can deduct from its taxes payable to Yukon a portion of the amounts it paid to:

- a registered political party of the territory;
- a registered constituency association of the territory; or
- a candidate seeking election to the territory's legislature.

Attach an official receipt to the return as proof of payment, and use the applicable column to calculate the allowable credit:

Yukon mineral exploration tax credit and research and development tax credit

Claim these two tax credits on line 91 of the trust's T3 return. For the mineral exploration tax credit, enter the amount of credit from Form T1199, *Yukon Mineral Exploration Tax Credit*, on line 91. For the research and development tax credit, enter the amount of credit from Form T1232, *Yukon Research and Development Tax Credit (Individuals)*, on line 91. In both cases, specify the type of credit in the blank space provided at line 91 and attach a copy of the form(s) to the return.
