Instructions

This application form may only be used by **retired members of the Canadian Forces or their next of kin** to apply for the **replacement** of those medals (as listed below) which are administered by the Department of National Defence, Directorate of Honours and Recognition (DH&R). Additional information can be found on our Internet web site under Directorate of Honours and Recognition (<u>http://www.forces.gc.ca/hr/dhr-ddhr/</u>).

Serving members of the Canadian Forces shall not use this form (their unit shall apply on-line (DIN) on their behalf in accordance with procedures detailed in CANFORGEN 106/00).


