## Topic: Provincial and Territorial Real Gross Domestic Product by Industry 2014 (preliminary) Released by Statistics Canada – April 28, 2015

**Background:** In Nunavut, GDP grew 6.2% in 2014, following growth of 11.5% in 2013.

> Mining, quarrying, and oil and gas extraction increased 9.9%. Engineering construction rose significantly as the development of a new mine progressed. Services output fell 1.5%, mainly because of a large decline in wholesale trade following deliveries to a mine site in 2013. In contrast, transportation and warehousing, health care and social assistance, as well as public administration increased.
