Topic:Building PermitsFebruary 2017Released by Statistics Canada, April 6, 2017

Background: The preliminary value of Nunavut building permits issued in January to February 2017 was **\$0.7 million**, a **decrease** of **81.4%** from January to February 2016.

In Canada, the preliminary value of building permits **increased** by **12.7%** from January to February 2016.

Note to Readers:

The Building Permits Survey covers 2,400 municipalities representing 95% of the population. It provides an early indication of building activity. The communities representing the other 5% of the population are very small and their levels of building activity have little impact on the total. The value of planned construction activities shown in this release excludes engineering projects (e.g., waterworks, sewers or culverts) and land. The data is collected from Municipal offices.
