Youth Court Statistics

2010/2011

Released by Statistics Canada – May 28, 2012

Background

In Nunavut there were **270** youth court cases completed during the 2010/2011 fiscal year, an increase of **20.5%** from 2002/2003, the year prior to the enactment of the new legislation. In Canada during the same period, the youth court caseload declined by **17.4%**.
