Topic: **Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Education Expenditures**

Released by Statistics Canada – May 2, 2016

Background: In Nunavut, a total of **\$147,626,000** was spent on Elementary and Secondary Education in 2013/2014 – up by **0.9%** from 2012/2013.
