Rebate Application Motor Vehicle or Heavy Equipment Purchased By Municipal Fire Department

Purchased by Volunteer Fire Department Purchasing Through A Municipality Rebate Based on Provincial Portion of HST

Eligibility Information

Rebate is equal to the lesser of \$7,929.00 or the provincial portion of the Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) paid, after the HST Public Service Bodies Rebate has been applied, on the purchase of a motor vehicle or heavy equipment used for fire-fighting by a Municipal Fire Department or a Volunteer Fire Department purchasing through a Municipality.

An applicant/purchaser must be able to provide satisfactory evidence that tax has been paid. The <u>Purchaser</u> of the motor vehicle or heavy equipment is the **only party** entitled to a rebate.

An application for rebate must be made within 24 months from the date that the tax was paid.

Documents required to be kept

All documentation supporting this rebate must be retained for audit purposes.

Instructions for completing the application

- 1. Give your details.
- 2. Provide details of the motor vehicle or heavy equipment.
- 3. Provide the cost of the motor vehicle or heavy equipment. The rebate is limited to a maximum of \$7,929.00.
- 4. Attach a copy of the following document to support your application:
 - a. A copy of the bill of sale or sales invoice under which the motor vehicle or heavy equipment was purchased showing the purchase price, HST paid, name of the seller and buyer, HST# of the seller and make, model and year.

Note: Failure to supply the required documents may result in delays in processing or a denial of your application

5. Before submitting the rebate application, review the application form to ensure that sections 1, 2 & 3 are complete and that the certification in Section 4 is signed.

Allow two to four weeks for processing. If your application is not complete, it will take longer.
