There seems to be a divergence in opinion on the possible dangers of this project so close to a source of human water use. However, in this matter, surely it would be better to err on the side of caution, of respect for the presently unexpected. Looking at the worst case scenario, surely it would be better to locate the waste disposal site further from concentrations of human habitation and use. In the past, we have encountered disastrous effects of unsuspected pollution in the Great Lakes area, and of unexpected nuclear contamination in eastern North America, among other instances.

We need to be very careful in our use of the earth, and not risk the possibilities of longterm bad results from what may look like commercially viable options.
