If a person has made a submission to the Panel that does not appear on the registry within a few days, they should contact the Panel Secretariat.

Further, correspondence addressed to the Joint Review Panel Outlook mailbox at dgr.review@ceaa-acee.gc.ca goes directly to that inbox. There is no redirection of incoming messages to a "SPAM FOLDER" or to any other folder. A DGR "SPAM FOLDER" does not exist.

The ***SPAM*** notation that may appear in the subject line of some messages is a label added to those messages by a Government of Canada application. This label is added to incoming messages that have certain characteristics (such as an extensive distribution list) to warn the recipient that the message may be SPAM. The addition of this label is for the protection of recipients and does not affect the delivery of the message in any way. Messages labelled with ***SPAM*** are received in the DGR mailbox, provided to and considered by the Joint Review Panel and processed and posted in exactly the same way as messages that are not labelled this way.

Hi Linda:

Hope all is well.

I would like to present the following Deputation to Council on Monday, May 13, 2013. Thank you.

To Mayor Smith and Council:

Our Council is supporting 2 DGRs being built in our Community within a few kilometres of one another.

<personal information removed> I participate in the Joint Review Panel process for the DGR for low and intermediate nuclear waste proposed for our Community that this Council supports. My submissions that I have sent to the Joint Review Panel have been directed to the **SPAM** folder of the Joint Review Panel so that my submissions cannot be posted on the Joint Review Panel Public Registry for review and consideration by my fellow Citizens and my submissions cannot be reviewed and considered by the Joint Review Panel. These are grave violations of my *Charter* and Democratic Rights and Freedoms.

The low and intermediate DGR is proposed to be built in our Community. Since it is being built in <identifiable information removed>Community it is of grave concern to all Citizens of Saugeen Shores. Since the DGR for high-level nuclear waste is probably also going to be built in <identifiable information removed>Community it is even more critical that all Citizens of Saugeen Shores be heard. The decisions made by the Joint Review Panel will affect Community FOREVER. There has never been a more important issue confronting <identifiable information removed> Community. There has never been a more important issue requiring that Democratic principles be followed, protected, and preserved.

I am asking<identifiable information removed> Mayor and Council to investigate these grave violations of my *Charter* and Democratic Rights and Freedoms. I know of at least other <identifiable information removed> that have not had their submissions posted on the Joint Review Panel's Public Registry. It is noteworthy that all of my submissions and those of the other <identifiable information removed> shut out of the process by the Joint Review Panel are critical of and challenge the Joint Review Panel process. These grave violations of the *Charter* and Democratic Rights and Freedoms of the Citizens of Saugeen Shores go to the heart and foundation of our free and Democratic society. We deserve answers. We demand answers. Democracy requires answers.

We depend on our elected Mayor and Council to preserve and protect this most valuable of all Democratic Rights -- to participate in a neutral and unbiased Due Process, without censor. Our Council is supporting 2 DGRs being built in our Community within a few kilometres of one another. Since 2 DGRs are probably going to be built in our Community, we need our Council to start showing leadership in this

and not meekly follow whatever process OPG, NWMO, and the Joint Review Panel dictate. Take a stand.
