Please note the availability of the reports by the independent experts retained by the Joint Review Panel on the Canadian Environmental Assessment Registry Internet Site (CEARIS) as outlined in the Panel Secretariat's <u>Notice</u> of September 6, 2013.

Dr. Peter Duinker was contracted for the provision of written and oral submissions with respect to the prediction of the significance of adverse environmental effects and the assessment of cumulative environmental effects. Dr. Duinker's report is CEARIS Document #1538 and he will appear at the public hearing to make a presentation to the Panel on October 3, 2013.

Dr. William Leiss was contracted to prepare a research paper that addresses the identification of stigma around nuclear facilities, including international waste repositories and a description of impact of these facilities on valued social components.
