The hearing will commence on September 9, 2014, and will continue for approximately two weeks at the Royal Canadian Legion in Kincardine, Ontario. The subjects to be addressed at the additional public hearing days are as follows:

- 1. Methodology used to determine the significance of adverse environmental effects
- 2. Updates to the geoscientific verification plan
- 3. Expansion plans for the DGR project
- 4. Relative risk analysis of alternative means of carrying out the project
- 5. Implications of revisions to the reference waste inventory
- 6. Applicability of recent incidents at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) to the safety case for the DGR project

The Joint Review Panel would like to thank the Historic Saugeen Métis for their participation to date in the review process for the DGR. As with the public hearing held in September 2013, it is of utmost importance to the Panel that the hearing be as accessible and respectful of Aboriginal cultures and interests as possible.
