The subject for September 11 and 12 is the risk analysis of alternative means. For days on which you are asked to be on standby, it is sufficient for you to have the appropriate subject-matter experts following the live webcast and easily contacted by telephone if there are questions. For that purpose, the Panel Secretariat will need the list of people you propose to have on standby, their titles and contact information.

As previously noted, the hearing will resume on September 9, 2014 and will continue over approximately two weeks at the Royal Canadian Legion, 219 Lambton Street, Kincardine, Ontario. The Panel will issue a detailed hearing
