- The objectives of the meeting were established as:
  - o conduct a walkthrough of the Mitigation Measures Report submitted on December 28, 2016;

- The proponent provided an overview of the Mitigation Measures Report, including the methodology used to develop the submission.
- The proponent clarified that Section 4 of the Mitigation Measures Report applies to the detailed mitigation measures provided in Appendix A, and confirmed that all commitments in Section 3 are up-to-date.
- The Agency requested OPG provide an addendum to the Mitigation Measures Report that cross-references OPG's commitments to the recommendations from the Joint Review Panel Report (CEARIS #2206). This information will assist the Agency and the public in identifying which of OPG's commitments relate to recommendations of the Joint Review Panel. This addendum should take the form of a table, similar to what was done in Appendix B.
  - Action: The Agency will send OPG a concordance table that correlates the recommendations from the Joint Review Panel Report (CEARIS #2206) to the draft potential conditions previously issued by the Agency (CEARIS #2214).
  - o **Action**: OPG will provide the addendum prior to start of the public comment period. Due date of January 13, 2017.
  - Action: Upon receipt, the Agency will post the addendum on the public registry prior to the start of the public comment period.
