**UCCM** - UCCM sent a letter requesting a meeting. CNSC has responded and is waiting to hear back and will be following-up.

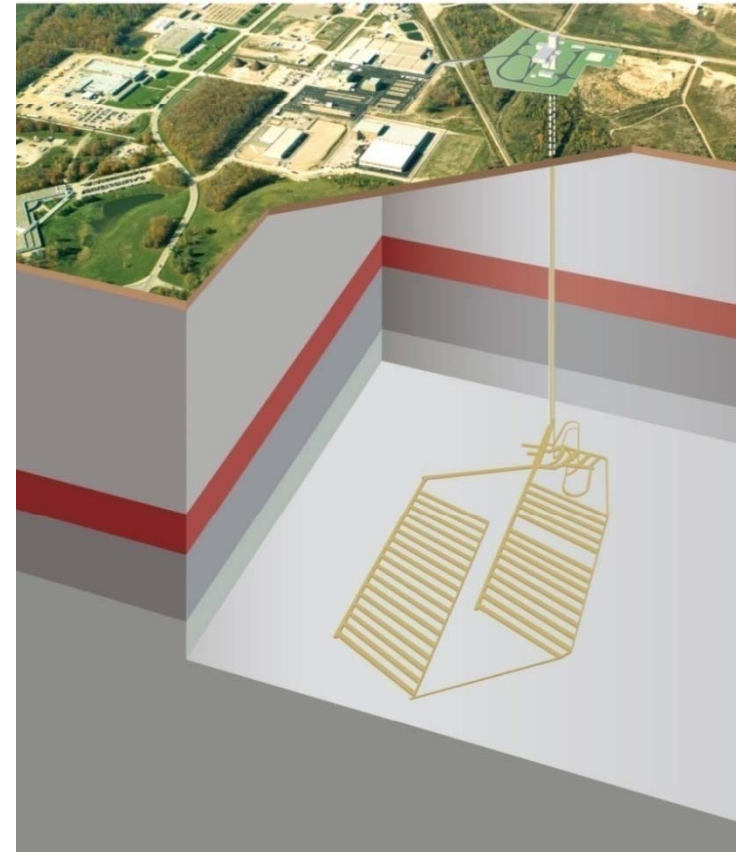
