**Subject:** CNSC Crown Consultation Update

Ms. McGee / Ms. Myles,

At the January 29th, 2013 Crown consultation update meeting, CNSC staff proposed a number of next steps.

I wanted to report on the status of those "next steps":

**SON**

For the Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON), at the January 22nd meeting, CNSC staff committed to bring their concerns forward to the Joint Review Panel, to offering subsequent meetings to continue discussions, to bring their concerns regarding the Adaptive Phase Management (APM) process to the Nuclear Waste Management Organization (NWMO) and Natural Resources Canada (NRCAN), and to consider technical sessions with the SON with respect to any concerns brought forward.

CNSC staff recently (April 22nd, 2013) sent a letter to the SON outlining the progress on these activities, as well as offering to meet to continue discussions. Within the letter, CNSC staff confirmed that they brought the SON's concerns forward to the JRP, NRCAN and NWMO regarding the APM in a recent meeting.

CNSC staff have been providing support to the SON with respect to IR submissions, as requested.

**MNO**

CNSC staff continue to communicate with the MNO, requesting information on Traditional Land Use, as it was indicated that it would be submitted on February 15, 2013.

**All interested Aboriginal groups**

When the close of the public comment period was announced - CNSC staff forwarded the announcement to each group to ensure that they are aware of the timelines. Follow-up phone calls/reminders will occur within the next week.
