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# Cape Breton East

The counties of Cape Breton and Richmond were divided into three electoral districts: Cape Breton East, Cape Breton Centre, and Richmond-West Cape Breton. (SNS 1925, c. 15, s.2)

In 1933, the district of Cape Breton was further divided into five electoral districts: Cape Breton North, Cape Breton East, Cape Breton South, Cape Breton Centre, and Cape Breton West. Cape Breton East consisted of that portion of the county of Cape Breton that contained the town of Glace Bay.

The Cape Breton East constituency name was changed to Glace Bay through an amendment to the House of Assembly Act (SNS 2001, c.16) in force June 1, 2001.

The NDP candidate, Cecil Saccary, won by 5 votes on election night. The judicial recount held on 17 August 1999 gave the seat to the Liberals by 5 votes. The NDP filed a Supreme Court petition on 2 September 1999 under the Controverted Elections Act to have the results voided and a by-election called.

Hearing held 25 January 2000 and 26 January 2000 and on 3 February 2000 the election was declared void by Justice Merlin
