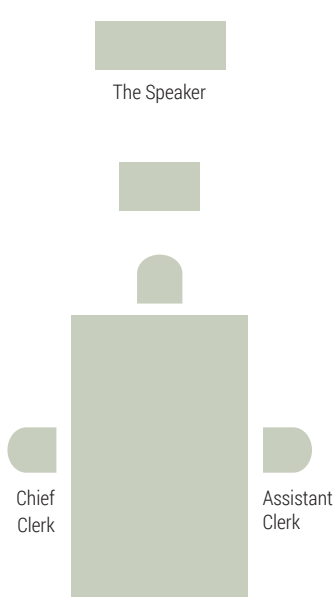
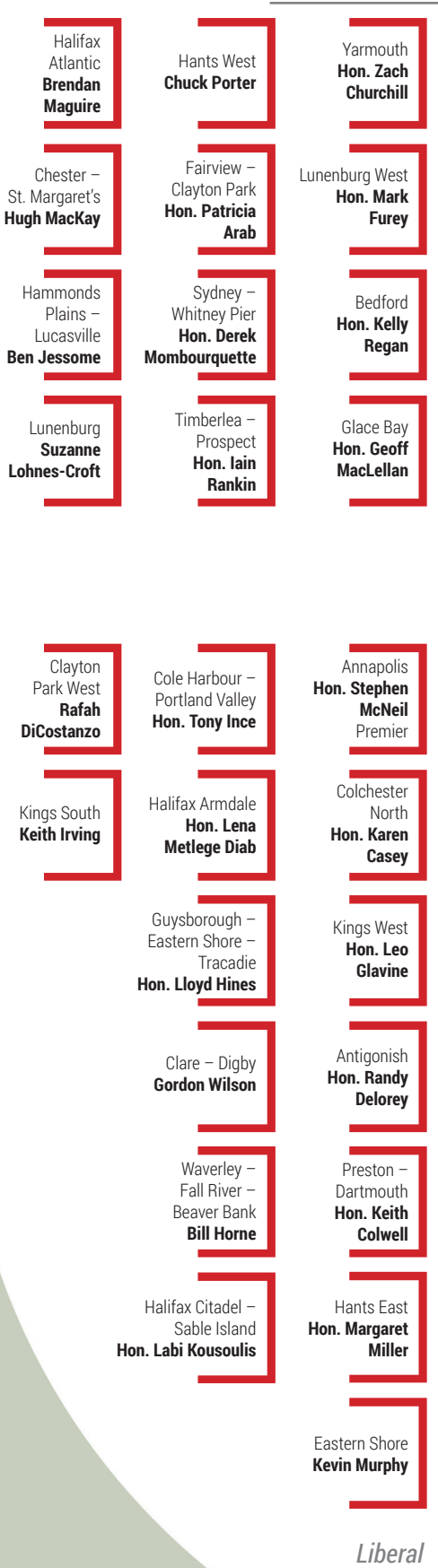

Rules for Pass User

You must comply with all security measures and follow directives given by security or Assembly personnel. As a visitor to the Gallery of the Legislative Chamber, you are not permitted to:

- use a cell or smart phone for talking (texting and emailing is permitted);
- take photos with any type of camera or device;
- audio or video record any part of the proceedings;
- applaud, cheer, whistle or make other audible sounds of any kind;
- demonstrate using a sign, banner, flag, clothing or other prop;
- conduct a protest;
- wear any head gear unless it is required as part of a service uniform, or is mandated for religious or cultural reasons;
- lean over or place items on the railing; or
- eat or drink.

You must be dressed respectfully and modestly at all times.

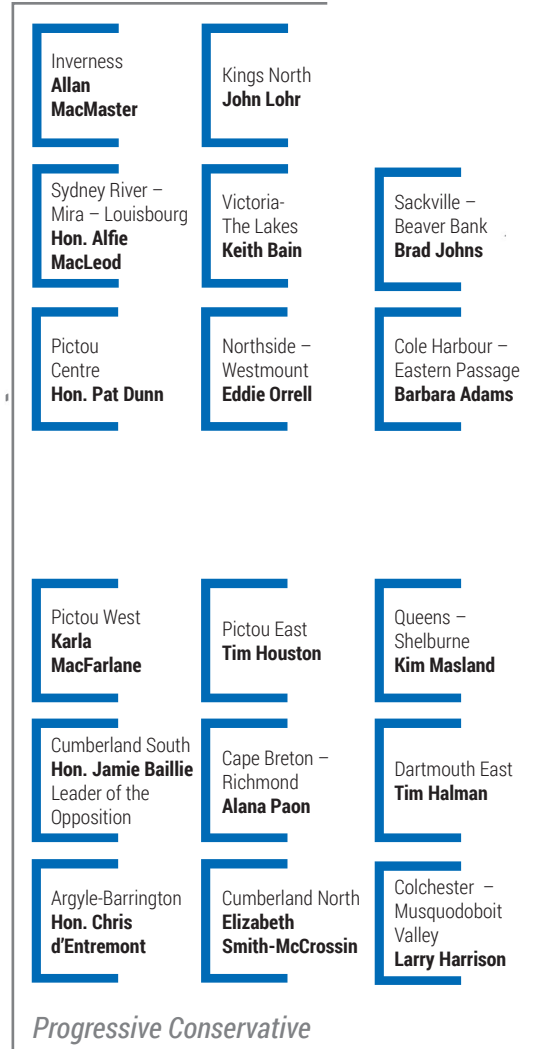

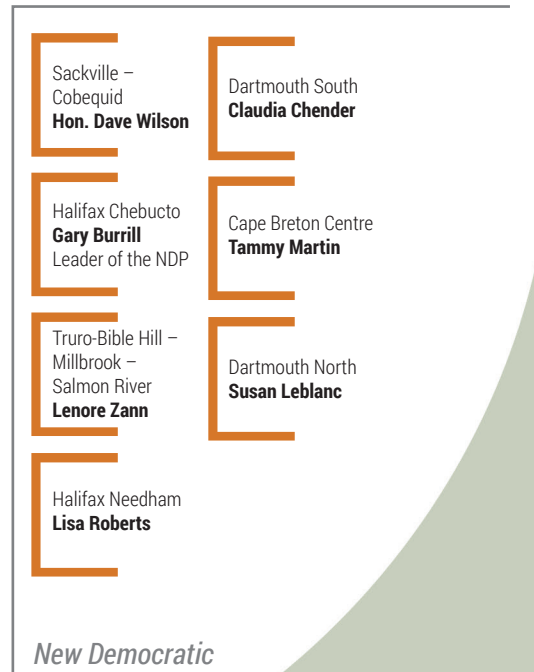
