Instructions

The corporation must complete this Notice for each eligible employee who exercised stock options eligible for this program during the tax year and who received or deferred the stock option benefit. The notice must be provided to the employee no later than six months after the end of the corporation's first taxation year ending after the calendar year in which the employee received or deferred the stock option benefit.

The corporation must also complete a *Notice of Benefit - Employee Summary* and provide it to the Ministry of Revenue.

Please complete a separate *Notice of Benefit* for each calendar year.

Eligible employees may qualify for a credit on up to \$100,000 of:

- taxable benefits from the exercise of stock options eligible for this program; and
- taxable capital gains from the sale of shares acquired through these options.

The credit will be deducted from the employee's taxable income to reduce or eliminate Ontario personal income tax.

The options must have been granted after December 21, 2000 and before May 18, 2004 and the taxable benefits and capital gains included in income on the employee's tax return for the year.

The "Ontario Eligible Stock Option Benefit" is the amount included in the employee's income in the year that is eligible for the ORESO Credit.

The "Deferred Ontario Eligible Stock Option Benefit" is the deferred amount that will be eligible for the ORESO Credit in the year of disposition.

General Information

Personal information on this Notice is collected under the authority of section 8.7 of the *Income Tax Act (Ontario)* and regulations and is provided to the Ontario Ministry of Revenue for the administration and audit of the ORESO Credit.
