Corporate Team Building Cancellation Policy

Volunteers are the backbone of Second Harvest. We rely on over 1,000 volunteers each year to help us fulfill our mission. Group cancellations can drastically affect the success of Second Harvest and its mission to help those experiencing hunger in our city.

Please note our cancellation policy has changed. Effective October 31st, 2014 we require one week notice if:

(a) you are unable to come to your volunteer shift as reserved, or

(b) the number of employees participating is going to be reduced by more than ten percent.

Insufficient notice will result in a forfeiture of the advance shift booking privilege. Repeated short-notice cancellations may result in suspension of volunteer privileges.

Special Events

Full volunteer attendance at events is critical. Commitments that are cancelled affect the experience of remaining volunteers and our overall success and reputation. Shifts will only be reserved if the group can guarantee the number of volunteers.

Food Sorts

Volunteer groups are crucial to food rescue and redistribution. Because we need to redistribute rescued food within a timely manner, sudden cancellations may result in unnecessary spoilage. We do our best to accommodate group food sorts but in the case that we have a shortage in food donations, we may have to re-schedule your volunteer day to a later date.
